Red Deer, AB (October 5, 2017) - In March of 2017, an agreement was signed between Agri-Trade Equipment Expo and Northlands, the producer of Farmfair International and the Canadian Finals Rodeo (CFR). Patrons will be able to take in both shows with the additional option of taking in the CFR. This will cost just \$30 and includes admission to both Farmfair International and Agri-Trade. CFR tickets will require an additional purchase.

"We are excited to offer this opportunity for patrons to both shows, and pleased to work with Agri-Trade in this joint promotion. Promoting ease of travel between the venues just makes good common sense for our farmers and ranchers."
